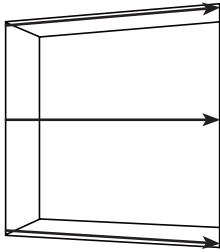


How to measure for Roman Shades

Shades - Inside mount application

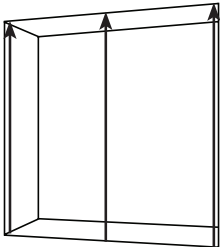
Width:

Measure the width of the window at 3 points and provide the smallest measurement.



Height:

Measure the length of the window at 3 points and provide the smallest measurement.



⊖ Deduct $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the measurement from the width to allow for clearance (inside mount). We will make the exact size you give us.

Shades - Outside mount application

Width:

Measure the width of the window from outer corner to outer corner.

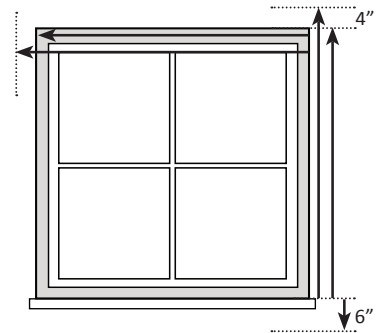
⊕ Add a minimum of 4" to both sides to block light from the sides.

Height:

Measure the drop from the top of the window to the bottom of the sill or floor. Measure both sides of the window and provide the smallest measurement.

⊕ Top: Add at least 4" to the measurement to ensure proper mounting of the blind.

⊕ Optional: When the window is not to the floor, extend the drop with an additional 6" below the window to block the light when closed.



If a window is out of square, or if width or height measurements vary greatly, we recommend using an outside mount for best appearance and performance.
